- Develop your knowledge of wholesale electricity markets and business intelligence through daily interactions with industry experts and stakeholders.
- Monitor, analyse & seek to influence legislative and policy developments on wholesale electricity markets and other related areas. In particular, the current energy price increase and the upcoming EC impact assessment on electricity market & legislative review.
- Interact with members to build consensus and develop Eurelectric's positions and policy recommendations on electricity wholesale markets and other energy-related issues.
- Develop and implement lobby campaigns and ensure external representation towards the EU institutions and other stakeholders.
